Sónar 2012

14th, 15th and 16th June 2012

Sónar 2012 will be presenting a high-octane line-up featuring performances and sessions by some of today's most thought-provoking performers from Spain and around the world. The Roots, who are considered by many to be the top hip-hop group of the moment; the classic New Order; Richie Hawtin; Lana del Rey; Amon Tobin, who will be presenting the spectacular visual show ISAM; James Blake; Fatboy Slim and Hot Chip are among the highlights of Sónar by Night which will take place, as usual, at the Gran Via trade fair site in L'Hospitalet. In addition to these top performers, the two nights of Sónar (on 15th and 16th June) will also feature James Murphy, Modeselektor, Metronomy, James Blake and Nicolas Jaar, and the showcases by the Hyperdub label and the British radio station BBC Radio 1, among many others. Sónar by Day will bring to the centre of Barcelona (in different areas of the MACBA and CCCB) for three days (14th, 15th and 16th June) an extraordinary line-up of performers headed

by the American producer Flying Lotus, who will be giving two performances; Mouse On Mars; John Talabot; Daedelus; Trevor Jackson; Peaking Lights and Pegasus, to name just some, as well as concerts and sessions hosted by the labels 100% Silk, Brainfeeder (both from the USA); the Catalan label Bankrobber, which is celebrating its 10th anniversary, and the platform for young talent from around the world, Red Bull Music Academy, which will be in charge of the SonarDôme stage. In addition to the musical performances, Sónar will also be presenting SonarPro, the area of the festival for professionals from the creative industry, which will be extending its activities this year. It will also feature the latest innovations in the field of technology applied to art and offer an exhibition of works by young talents who have received an MA from the Music Technology Group at Pompeu Fabra University.

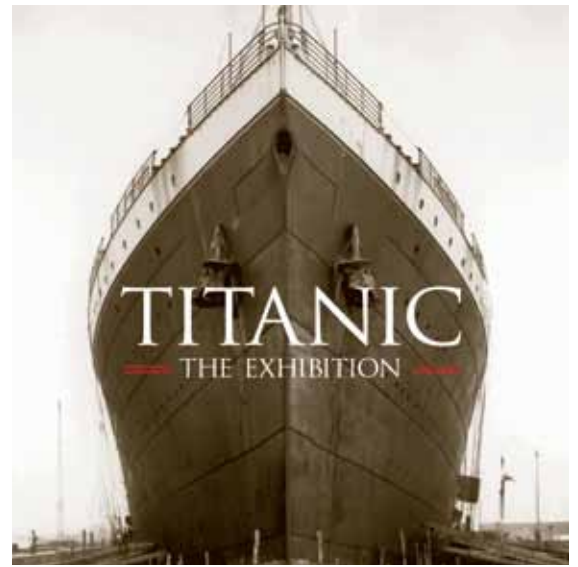

Titanic. The Exhibition

Titanic. The Exhibition is now at the Museu Marítim de Barcelona just in time to commemorate the centenary of the sinking of the liner *RMS Titanic*. The exhibition takes visitors back in time so that they can find out what life was like on board the short-lived ship from the time of its construction to the current state of its wreckage, which lies

almost 4km deep under the North Atlantic. Almost 200 real objects, the faithful recreations of the rooms inside, including the cabins and first class corridors, and an accurate portrayal of the history of the ship, have made this one of the world's most visited touring exhibitions.

PortAventura

PortAventura is a theme park complex located between the towns of Vila-seca and Salou. The six themed areas (Mediterranean, Far West,

Mexico, China, Polynesia and SésamoAventura) cover 119 hectares and feature 30 rides and attractions, 100 performances every day,

75 bars and restaurants and 27 shops selling handicrafts and gifts. The park has four hotels, a water park (PortAventura Aquatic Park) and a convention centre that can host 4.000 people. This year's new attractions at PortAventura include Shambhala, Europe's highest roller coaster (76 m). In addition to the roller coaster, Shambhala recreates the imaginary Himalayan kingdom set within 14.000 square metres of themed landscape. The park is also planning other new attractions and initiatives, including five new shows and a road safety school for children. All these things, together with its excellent location on the Costa Daurada and transport links have made PortAventura a unique family and leisure attraction in Europe.

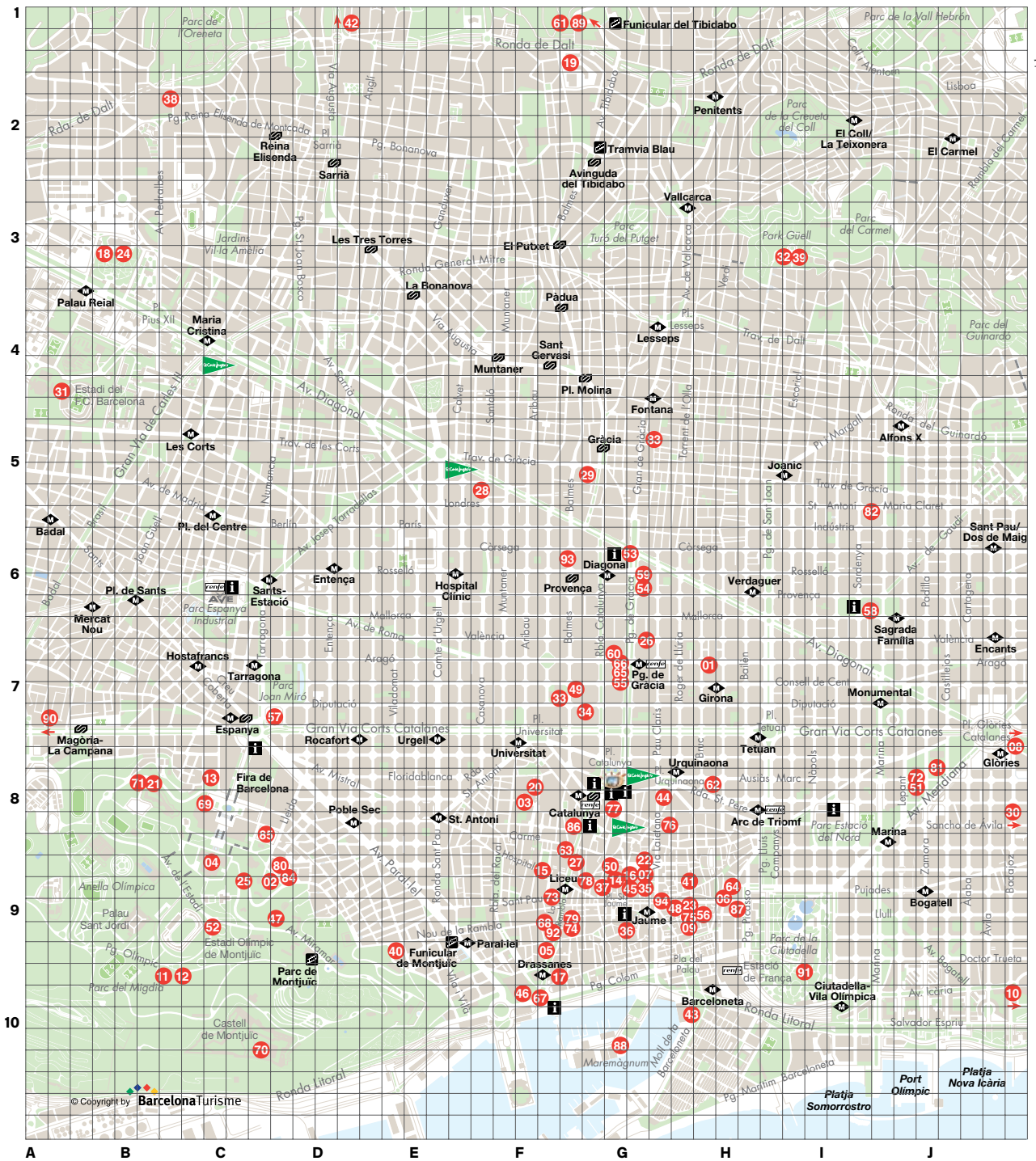


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
